

Gardener / Caretaker Wanted by Mary Tavy Parish Council

Mary Tavy Parish Council is seeking to appoint a gardener / caretaker for 2013 on a contract basis to undertake gardening and general maintenance activities for designated areas within the Parish that council is responsible for.

Duties would include:-

- Cutting the grass and hedge at the Mary Tavy cemetery. Removal from site of all cuttings.
- Emptying the rubbish from the parish cemetery bin fortnightly in line with West Devon Borough Council's published refuse collection schedule.
- Grass Cutting/edge strimming at Blackdown Village Green. Removal from site of all cuttings.
- Hedge cutting at Mary Tavy Parish Cemetery. The Parish Council expects this only to be required a maximum of bi-annually.
- Weeding around the War Memorial. The Parish Council expects this only to be required a maximum of bi-annually.

The successful candidate would be required to have their own power and hand tools including lawnmower, strimmer (to strim around the graves in the cemetery), and hedge trimmer (to trim the cemetery hedge) twice per year.

The successful candidate would however be covered by the Parish Council Public Liability Insurance for 3rd party liability.
