

## Mary Tavy Parish Council

### Monthly grass cutting and maintenance tasks (Summer and Autumn)

1 x grass cut of the parish cemetery every **two weeks** (the fenced-off area at the top of the churchyard only)

1 x weed spray session of the cemetery paths (including the path through the churchyard that leads to the parish cemetery) every **two weeks\***

1 x weed spray session of the base of the war memorial and the adjacent gravel area\*

1 x grass cut of the grassed area adjacent to the bus shelter on the A386

1 x grass cut of the grassed area surrounding the outdoor gym equipment on the Recreation Field

1 x grass cut of the verge on the corner of Station Road (cut from the kerbside to the 'wilding' sign, not too close to the daffodils next to the hedge)

1 x strim of the grass surrounding three dog bins in the parish (1-2 feet clearance required, to allow people to use the dog bins). Dog bins located on: Warne Lane, Bal Lane and on the Recreation Field.

1 x strim of the grass surrounding two telephone boxes in the parish (1-2 feet clearance required, to allow people to use the telephone boxes). Telephone boxes located on: the lane leading to the parish cemetery and at the top of Bal Lane.

1 x grass cut, the small verge in Horndon where the telephone box and dog bin are located.

**Estimated hours to complete tasks: 5 per week on a temporary self-employed basis (the successful candidate will be invited to submit a tender for a three-year contract in due course)**

**Total monthly payment = £285**

\* The parish council only accepts the use of bee-friendly weedkillers. Pelargonic acid is one such weedkiller and is the main active ingredient in the 'natural' weedkiller that is manufactured by Round-Up (other brands are available). Please keep the receipt for reimbursement.
